Registration is necessary for Religious Education Classes and Sacrament Preparation. If you have questions, contact our Parish Office, 279-4403.

MASS INTENTIONS

Mass Intentions may be scheduled at the parish office. The suggested donation is \$10. Parishioners may request only one weekend Mass Intention per month. Mass intentions may not be scheduled for consecutive Holydays/Holidays. Mass cards are available when scheduling your intention. Please stop by or call the parish office to schedule your Mass Intentions.



SUMMER PARKING

We have overflow, unpaved parking lots to the left of the church as you are facing the front entrance. If you find that the lots are full, there is also a large parking lot in back of the church. There is a rear entrance to the building. It is on the right side of the rear of the building. It is clearly marked for church and chapel use. We also have an elevator if you need it, at the rear entrance, to come up to the church.



HOSPITAL VISITS

Please remember to register St. Charles as your parish if you are a patient at Lakes Region Hospital. Sr. Harriet visits regularly with our parishioners in the hospital.



BAPTISM INFORMATION

If you are expecting a child, *now* is the time to call the parish office. Baptism is available to registered parishioners. Baptisms are scheduled only after the parents have participated in the Parish Baptismal Catechesis.
